Payments & Invoices

- School fees are payable in advance via EFT or Debit Order by the 1st of each month.
- Invoices are sent by the 24th of each month. If you haven't received yours by the 28th, please let us know.
- Families joining after January on the 11-month plan will have their fees adjusted accordingly.
- First invoices (registration, stationery, etc.) must be paid via EFT. From the second month, fees can be paid by Debit Order or EFT.
- Fees are reviewed yearly and may increase by up to 10%, effective from the next invoice.

Additional Charges

- Stationery is for classroom use and is non-refundable if you withdraw during the year.
- Toiletries not sent on the due dates will be billed after one week.
- Please avoid cash deposits into CKP's account. This incurs a 5% bank fee.
- Incorrect payments into the CKP account will carry a R50 refund fee.

Late Payments

- Payments after the 1st attract a 5% late fee.
- Fees unpaid by the 9th will result in suspension until payment is received.

Refunds & Non-Refundables

- No refunds for missed days (holiday or sickness).
- · No refunds on December fees, Grade R books (if leaving early), or fees spread over 11 months if you withdraw before year-end.
- The 12th month's fees are non-refundable and cannot be used as a notice month.

4. ACCIDENTS + FIRST AID

- Your child's safety is our priority. All head teachers are trained in basic first aid and may administer treatment when needed.
- If your child has a head or facial injury, we will phone you immediately.
- For minor scrapes and bumps, a note will be shared with you on Seesaw, so you are always informed.
- If your child comes home with a mark that wasn't reported on Seesaw, please know this may be because 1. they didn't mention it, 2. the teacher didn't witness it, or 3. it didn't affect them during the school day, so the teacher was unaware. You're always welcome to bring it to our attention so we can observe and help prevent it from happening again.
- In the unlikely event of a serious accident requiring hospital care, we will first try to contact you for consent. If we cannot reach you, CKP is authorised to act on your behalf to ensure your child receives immediate emergency treatment.

5. ACADEMICS AND ASSEMBLY

- We seek to excel in developing the whole child. Each teacher is equipped to guide children to their full potential in line with age-appropriate
 outcomes. Our integrated learning approach often goes beyond what is expected in ELDAs, CAPS, and similar curriculums.
- Assessments and observations take place throughout the year, with Academic Reports issued in the <u>2nd and 3rd term</u>. We follow a 3-term calendar.
- While we are proudly Christian and intentional about building strong Christian foundations, we place just as much importance on Academic
 foundations. In the preschool years, learning happens best through play. This allows children to grasp new concepts naturally, while developing
 across all areas physical, intellectual and cognitive, social and emotional, and speech and language. This is what we call integrated learning.
- Each day begins with Assembly, where all age groups start together with Praise and Worship, a Bible verse, and a Bible story or character trait.

6. BIRTHDAYS

- Parents are welcome to send a cake or cupcakes on or close to their child's birthday and join the class for a special birthday ring. This can be
 arranged with the teacher in advance and will take place during snack time at 10:00ish.
- Please DO NOT send party packs or extra sweets the cake and excitement of the day are more than enough.

9. FUNCTION FRIDAYS

These events include Valentine's Day, Easter, Mother's/Father's/Special Person's Day, and Heritage Day. They are held in our café between 7:00—8:30 in the morning, before you head off to work. Parents are invited to join their children for snacks, crafts, and fellowship with other families.
 Depending on the event, we may also have extras like face painting, nail painting, sensory play, and more. Reminders will go out in the termly newsletter, with a detailed invite sent closer to the time.

10. HOLIDAY PROGRAM

- The Holiday Program is open to all enrolled children and includes fun, themed activities. The cost is **R700 per term** and will be automatically added to your **April**, **August**, and **December invoices** if your child attends during these times.
- Also open to children aged 2-8 (toilet trained) who are not enrolled at CKP. Half + Full-day options available, please email for costs & activity list.

11. GRADE R UNIFORM

Part of preparing for "Big School" is learning to wear a uniform. At CKP we use a simple step-in approach: a CKP shirt (worn daily) and a CKP hoodie
(for winter). These items are compulsory for all Gr R children and will be billed accordingly. We recommend purchasing more than one shirt, so your
child has a clean one available each day.

12. INDEPENDENCE

- Independence Independence is a vital life skill we aim to encourage in all children. We guide them to enter their classroom with confidence, carry their own bag, unpack their belongings, and take responsibility for tidying up after themselves.
- "Drop and Go" Please allow your child the opportunity to grow in confidence by making use of our *Drop and Go* system. Walk your child into school (without carrying them), give a quick goodbye, reassure them you'll be back later, and then leave. Beforehand, remind them of the exciting day ahead a positive, confident send-off helps them settle much faster.
- **Personal Belongings** As your child develops independence, there may be days when they forget to pack all their belongings. Teachers will remind them, but please also help encourage this skill by checking with your child at home.

13. MEALS

We're very proud to offer a 3-week rotating menu that keeps mealtimes fresh and exciting while giving children exposure to a variety of foods, textures, and flavours. Each meal is thoughtfully planned to provide the right balance of vitamins and nutrients to support healthy growth. For our full-day children, we've added a 4:00 p.m. snack, just enough to keep little tummies happy until dinner!

Deviations from the menu will take place from time to time for various reasons If your child is allergic to any of the above food ingredients, please inform your class teacher. In such cases, you may send alternative food for your child.

a) Baby Bunnies Meals (3-14 months)

- Due to the introduction of solid foods being a very important time, we believe that in order for our parents to be completely satisfied with what our babies are being served during the day, each baby has their own snacks and solid meals sent from home.
- Once your little one is ready to join in with CKP meals, please let the teacher know and she will gladly assist with the transition.

b) Little Lambs-Wise Owls Meals (14 months – Grade R)

- No extra food needs to be sent from home. A clearly labelled, filled water bottle must be packed in your child's bag each day.
- For the safety of all children, please do not send any food or snacks containing peanuts or other nuts.
- Junk food items such as sugary drinks, chocolates, or chips are not permitted and will be sent back home.

14. NOTICE PERIOD

- One full calendar month's written notice must be submitted to CKP on or before the 1st of the notice month if you intend to withdraw your child.
 Fees remain payable in full for the notice month.
- Both 11-month and 12-month fee options are subject to the full months' notice period.
- For withdrawals at the end of the school year <u>31 December</u>, written notice must be submitted **on or before the 1**st **November.** Please note that December notice will not be accepted, and fees remain payable until <u>31 December</u>.
- If notice is received after the 1st, the notice period automatically extends into the following month.
- Any change in enrolment (e.g., Full Day to Half Day) also requires one full calendar month's written notice, submitted on or before the 1st of the
 month.

15. MEDICATION

- Medication will only be administered at midday after lunch (approx. 11:45). The morning dose must be given at home before school.
- Written consent via Seesaw is required, stating the child's name, medication, dosage, and dates for administration. The medication must be handed directly to the teacher on arrival no medication may be left in a child's bag.
- If your child travels with a transport service, please ensure the driver hands the medication directly to the teacher on duty.
- Parents are responsible for collecting all medication at pick-up time each day.
- CKP staff cannot administer nebulizers, suppositories, vitamins, or immune boosters these must be given at home.
- CKP reserves the right to refuse administration of any medication if deemed necessary.

If your child has any of the following, they may not attend school:

- ✓ Green running nose
- ✓ Had a fever in the last 24 hours above 38® or higher.
- ✓ Running tummy in the last 24 hours
- ✓ Coughing
- ✓ Body spots
- ✓ Nits or lice
- ✓ Weeping eyes
- ✓ Ears draining fluid
- ✓ Sores that do not heal within 48 hours.

16. SICKNESS AND ILLNESS

- It is normal for children starting school to experience more frequent illness as their immune systems strengthen. While we sanitize daily, fog weekly, and wash hands regularly, it is not possible to prevent all sickness.
- If your child has a fever, vomiting, or diarrhea, they may only return after being symptom-free (without medication) for 48 hours.
- Children with contagious illnesses will need a medical clearance certificate before returning to school. CKP may request a child's withdrawal during school hours if illness is suspected.
- Parents must inform CKP of any illnesses or allergies before attendance.
- CKP supports working parents but reserves the right to contact you for collection if your child becomes unwell during the day.
- Please note: CKP accepts no responsibility for children contracting contagious illnesses.

17. SECURITY

- Children will not be released to anyone unknown to staff unless prior written arrangements have been made with CKP.
- Parents must send a Seesaw message with the name, surname, and a copy of the collector's ID. Proof of identity (ID, passport, or driver's license)
 will be checked on arrival.
- · For safety reasons, children will not be released to Uber drivers under any circumstances, even with parental consent.

18. SEPARATION ANXIETY

- Separation anxiety is very common when children first start school and can take 1–3 weeks to settle, depending on each child. Mondays are often the hardest, but with time, patience, and consistency, they will soon adjust.
- Our teachers are equipped to guide children through this transition by keeping them close, offering love and reassurance, and engaging them in play and conversation. We encourage parents to keep drop-off quick a kiss, a reassuring reminder that you'll be back, and then walking away confidently.
- Crying or resistance is normal and can happen at any stage, but staying positive and sending your child daily helps them settle faster and grow to love school.

19. TOILET TRAINING

- Toilet training is a special milestone, and we work closely with parents to maintain continuity between home and school. Parents of children in our 2-3-year-old class (Busy Bears) are responsible for starting the process and should inform the teacher once training has begun. We follow a scheduled toilet routine, shared in a detailed letter with tips and guidance. This is given at the start of the year, but parents may request it earlier if needed.
- Busy Bears begin toilet training in February, and Little Lambs begin at the start of the 3rd term.

20. WHAT TO SEND IN THE BAG

Baby Bunnies (3-15 months) - Please label ALL your child's belongings.

- <u>Bottles</u> filled with the correct water measurement or a flask of hot water.
- Formula Dispenser with correct scoops of formula pre-measured for each bottle.
- o <u>Breastmilk</u> to be kept in fridge and decanted into bottles if breastfeeding.
- Water bottle/Sippy cup.
- <u>Dummy + Clip + container</u> If applicable.
- o Meals AM + PM snack + Breakfast + Lunch If baby is on solids.
- <u>Clothing</u> warm and cool change of clothing.
- o Nappies for the week. Nappy changing wet wipes will be kept at school in their nappy container.
- o Sun Hat kept at school and used when needed. Please apply sunblock prior to bringing your child to school.

Little Lambs - Busy Bears (1-3)

- Clothing warm and cool change of clothing.
- o <u>Water bottle</u> Filled with water and sent daily. No juice.
- o Sun Hat to be kept at school/in their bag and used when needed. Please apply sunblock prior to bringing your child to school.
- o Nappies for the week. Nappy changing wet wipes will be kept at school in their cubby.

Leaping Lizards - Wise Owls (3 - Gr R)

- <u>Clothing</u> warm and cool change of clothing.
- o <u>Water bottle</u> Filled with water and sent daily. No juice.
 - Sun Hat to be kept at school/in their bag and used when needed. Please apply sunblock prior to bringing your child to school.

21. RULES OF CONDUCT AT SCHOOL

- No toys from home they cause fights, get lost or broken. We have plenty at school.
- No gumboots or lace-up shoes they restrict safe movement on the playground and jungle gym.
- <u>Hair must be tied back/out of the face</u> so children can play and participate comfortably.
- <u>Dresses/skirts must be worn with tights or shorts</u> so girls can climb and play freely.

These rules help us keep play safe, happy, and fun for everyone.
